

Game Day Instructions and Information

Games at JM

- Bases are stored in the Moraga Baseball Knaack boxes located next to JM7. There is no lock on the box. The bases are placed on top of the base plates. There should be a double base to be used at 1st base.
- If the pitching rubber isn't in place on the field before the game, you will have to put it in place. For 10U the pitching distance is 35 feet, and for 12U/14U it is 40 feet. No pitching rubber is necessary for 7U and 8U, since we are doing coach pitch.
- At the end of the games at JM, place the bases in the Knaack Box.

Games at STANLEY

- For games, you will need to put bases on the field. They are stored in the Knaack Boxes next to Stanley 1. The box at Stanley 1 is locked. The combinations is 2999. Please make sure to keep the Knaack Box locked.
- The pitching rubbers should be in place on the field, but if not, you will have to put them in place. For the 10U division, the pitching distance is 35 feet, and for the 12U/14U division, it's 40 feet. No pitching rubber is necessary for 7U and 8U, since we are doing coach pitch.
- At the end of the last game place the waffle bases back in the Knaack Boxes.

Games at UPPER COMM and CHANEY

- For games, you will need to put bases on the field. There are pegs in the field for these bases.
- The pitching rubber is in place on the field.
- At the end of the last game place the bases back in the Knaack Boxes. The Knaack Boxes are in place on these fields but not yet locked. More information to follow.
- Please make sure to close all gates at Upper Comm for the dugout and field access when games are over.
